Scott White and Hookins were appointed by the Croydon Schools to assist with School Travel Planning works, in order to satisfy the requirements of the London Borough of Croydon with regard to the use of a Council building as an Annexe to the existing infants and junior Schools at Whitehorse Manor, Thornton Heath.

A Framework Travel Plan had originally been produced by SWH, but the Council wanted additional work to be carried out in advance of the school annexe opening.

Therefore, Scott White and Hookins were able to produce an updated Action Plan for the attention of the Headteacher over the summer break, as well as producing a Deliveries and Servicing Management Plan. This included a commitment to use a "Cargo Bike" for distribution of deliveries from the main school site to the annexe.

Lastly, Scott White and Hookins produced a double-sided Travel Information Pack for Parents, Pupils and Staff which would be circulated. This showed on one side a map of local public transport services and cycling and walking routes, and on the other side provided text-based information to further assist with raising awareness of the available options.
