Scott White and Hookins provided Structural Engineering services on the refurbishment of Hyde House, a Grade II* listed house and adjacent Grade II listed barn in Winchester. The buildings were wholly refurbished and upgraded and a new link building constructed to provide modern offices for ADAM Architecture.

Many aspects of the structural alterations had to be sensitive to the historic nature of the buildings. This included working in consultation with the Winchester City Council Conservation Officer, with regular meetings on site, to ensure the buildings' heritage was respected and retained.

The project included some underpinning works and an existing masonry wall was completely removed, documented, stored on site and rebuilt in its original state.
